

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS


- Use caution when on podium platform. Platform is raised 42" above ground, be aware of falling hazard.
- Use handrails when climbing up and down the stairs.
- **Do not lean on Boundary Rail.** The Boundary Rail visually defines the platform space for safety while standing on the podium. It is not intended to support weight as a guardrail.
- No more than one person on the podium. The Marching Band Podium is designed and intended for use with one person at a time.
- Make sure that all fasteners are properly engaged before use.
- Save these instructions. Refer to them frequently and use them to instruct others who may use the Conductor's Podium.
- Read the Product Information Packet. Failure to read the information packet is considered a misuse of this equipment.
- Become familiar with all caution and warning decals affixed to the field equipment before
 use.
- Never cover or deface caution/warning labels.



- Boundary rail can be folded up or left down according to drum major's preference.
- Integrated casters allow for easy transportation from storage to practice to performance.
- Textured aluminum platform and stair treads for traction and weather resistance.
- All pieces integrated with no separate pieces to store.
- Deep stair treads with handrails for added safety while climbing stairs.
- Positively locks in both open and closed positions for easy setup and take down.



- ASTM A513 tubing, steel plate
- Extruded 6061-T6 Aluminum
- Polyurethane casters
- Zinc plated hardware grade 5 or equivalent
- Baked on powder coat finish


User Instructions



To open the Marching Band Podium, first release rubber latches, then lift stairs and pull unit toward you until it is standing upright.




Lift the platform and walk the legs toward the stairs and lock them in place with the rubber latches. The podium can now be easily transported on its wheels, using the platform edge as a handle.



The Marching Band Podium can be transported without folding it by using the lock pin under the platform. Remove the pin from its storage position, and insert it through the hole on the lock pin bracket, and through the cross brace that the platform rest on. This will lock the platform in place to safely move the podium.


Assembly Instructions




Attach handrails with 1/4" x 3 1/2 bolts and nuts. Wrench size is 7/16".

Attach wheel brackets with 1/4" x 3 1/2 bolts and nuts. Wrench size is 7/16".



Attach Boundary Rail brackets with $\frac{1}{2}$ x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ bolts and nuts. Wrench size is $\frac{7}{16}$. Be sure the bracket with 2 notches is on the left hand side of the podium.
